POST TOUR → CEBU-BOHOL

DAY 1: FEBRUARY 4, 2019

Transfer to airport
Depart Manila to Cebu
Arrive Cebu
Proceed for Cebu City Tour
Visit Cebu's historical sites and landmarks: Fort San Pedro, the oldest triangular fortress in the country built in 1565; Magellan's Cross, planted on April 14, 1521 by Ferdinand Magellan; Basilica Minore del Santo Niño, Cebu's oldest church built by Miguel Lopez de Legazpi in 1565, now housing the statuette of the Santo Niño; Casa Gorordo Museum, former house of the first Bishop of Cebu; the Taoist Temple, located in the Beverly Hills, overlooking the city of Cebu and Mactan.
Transfer to hotel
Overnight stay at Costabella Tropical Beach Hotel

DAY 2: FEBRUARY 5, 2019

Breakfast at the hotel
Proceed for Island Hopping Tour
A visit to Cebu is not complete without cruising the islands of Mactan on board a local motorized banca. Swim or snorkel off the islands of Hilitungan, Nalusuan or go birdwatching of Olango Island. Have a barbecue lunch at Nalusuan Island. It is recommended that rubber slippers or booties be worn. Barbecue lunch, boat ride, and return transfers to Cebu City hotels or Mactan resorts are included.
Return to hotel
Overnight stay at Costabella Tropical Beach Hotel

DAY 3: FEBRUARY 6, 2019

Breakfast at the hotel
Check-out
Transfer to Cebu Pier
Depart Cebu for Tagbilaran via Oceanjet or similar
Arrive Tagbilaran
Proceed for Bohol Countryside Tour with lunch
Home to the famous Chocolate Hills, Bohol is a quaint getaway from the rest of the world. With its white sand beaches, clear blue seas, lush tropical vegetation, and diving spots, Bohol promises to be an unforgettable holiday destination. The tour begins with a drive through the majestic Mahogany Man-Made Forest on your way to the Chocolate Hills, a unique geographical cluster of 1,268 cone-shaped ground formations that look like gigantic chocolate truffles waiting to be eaten. Then, on to the Baclayon Church, one of the oldest stone churches in the Philippines housing religious artifacts dating back to the 16th century. A countryside ride to the Blood Compact Shrine brings you to the site where Datu Sikatuna forged a truce with Conquistador Miguel Lopez de Legazpi and gives you a scenic view of the island. Drive back to Loboc for the Loboc River Cruise where you will be serenaded while having your barbecue lunch.
Transfer to hotel for check-in
Overnight stay at Mithi Resort & Spa
